



QUILT SHOW BOUTIQUE GUIDELINES

The goal of the Quilt Show Boutique is to create an inviting “shop” in our show where our members can sell high quality, hand-made quilts and quilt-related items to our show visitors.

1. All items should be made of fabric and/or be quilt-related.
2. All items must be made by CRGQG members.
3. All items should be new and handmade.
4. All participants are requested to support the show by volunteering in the Boutique or where help is needed for at least one scheduled shift.
5. The guild will collect the sales money, deduct 15%, then issue a check to participants for monies due.
6. Items for sale should be tagged with the price and seller’s initials before they are brought to the show.

Schedule:

1. The show will be here faster than you realize. Here are some ideas you might consider to get your items completed on time.
 - Start early. Set a limit on what you will make.
 - Decide the best way to make your items - assembly line or one item finished before another is started.
 - When you are making gifts, make one or two extra for the Boutique.
 - Work on items at retreats or at group sewing days;
 - Save handwork for travel or time spent waiting for appointments.
2. Complete your Boutique Submission form and hand it to the Boutique Coordinator, Gini Bright, at the August guild meeting or mail it to Gini (address on the form).
3. Bring your items with price tags attached to the Hood River Armory on show set-up day, Thursday, October 17.
4. All items to be sold should be contained in a plastic bag or cardboard box clearly marked with your name, to keep them in excellent condition and available for restocking as other items are sold.
5. Show time is October 18-19, 2019.
6. We request that unsold items be picked up by 5:30pm on Saturday, October 19. The Boutique Coordinator and the Guild are not responsible for any items not picked up.
